March is upon us and the demand for our services continues to be strong. Our reputation for Quality

and Caring is reaching far and wide with referrals coming in from Clifton Locals and from across South East Old.

It was great to catch up with so many people at the Clifton Show, Our stand looked fantastic and the residents of Sunflower Lodge had great success with their pavilion entries.

The Royal Commission into Aged Care Quality and Safety has commenced and we have lodged our submission to assist with the process, we remain hopeful that this once in a lifetime chance to improve the overall system will be taken by all the relevant decision makers.

We have been successful with a small FRRR training grant which will provide \$5000 of additional dementia training for our community and we hope to utilise it to run as many people as possible through a program call the virtual dementia tour.

We continue to await the results of our 2018 Aged Care Approval Round

Submission which are expected in approx. April 2019, if successful this application will provide us with capital funding to undertake major refurbishments on some of the older parts of our existing buildings.
